COMMUNITY PRIORITIES

■ Key concerns included:

- Safety (vehicles and pedestrians/bicyclists)
- Access (some desire to maintain access with intersection improvements, and some desire to close access to/from CSAH 17)
- Speed
- Bicycle/pedestrian (safety and access)
- Impacts to property (physical and value impacts)
- Frontage road too close to intersection
- Passing on shoulder along CSAH 17
- Difficulty seeing traffic signals/drivers not paying attention along TH 36

■ Improvement suggestions or components that came up often include:


- Construct an overpass
- Reduce speeds
- Improve pedestrian/bicycle access
- Improve frontage road(s)
- Traffic control change (signal removal, and conversion to a two-way stop-controlled intersection)
