Engagement Summary



Washington County has completed the first phase of engagement for the County Road 19A/100th Street Realignment project. In this phase, the County:

- Notified the public of the County’s plans to move forward with preliminary design on the County Road 19A/100th Street Realignment project, covering the easternmost portion of the Southwest Arterial Study from the US 61 interchange to Jamaica Avenue
- Recapped the alternatives developed and evaluated for the preliminary design of the first phase of the project
- Displayed the preferred alternative that will move forward into preliminary design
- Provided an opportunity for the public to ask questions and share feedback on the project
- Shared next steps and ways to stay involved

In-Person Open House

On February 2, 2023, Washington County hosted an in-person open house. The open house featured display boards with project information and large scale project aerials. Project staff were available to discuss the project and answer questions. Approximately 36 people attended the open house.

Attendees at the in-person open house could provide feedback on paper project questionnaires and/or by talking to project staff. Below are the open house comments received.











Do you have any comments for the project team?

I am very concerned about the plans for developing the Mississippi Dunes and Grey Cloud Island. As a Green Step city member, the City of Cottage Grove has the responsibility to preserve and protect natural landscapes, especially along the Mississippi River. This region is also part of the National Park of the Mississippi River Critical Corridor Area. The Dunes, and especially Grey Cloud Island should NOT be developed. It should, instead, be preserved as parkland. The DNR has expressed the desire (and have the money) to buy and manage both areas. The City and County need to work together to protect and preserve the Mississippi Dunes and Grey Cloud Island as natural space and parkland, NOT developed parkland, but natural park.

Regarding the road development, I am 100% opposed to building new roads to accommodate future development the community does not want. We do not want new roads or highways to the island and need to prioritize protecting natural land instead of developing everything.

Any decisions on development should be put to a public vote. Open houses with no notice and held during the work day are unacceptable. Please listen to what the constituents want, which is natural, preserved parkland, NOT development.

Regarding the proposal, I don't understand the need for it. It seems to me like we should be preserving more land rather than taking land (via right of way, housing developments, etc.).

Grey Cloud Island Township is a rural area with single family homes. We don't need or want our tax dollars wasted on more development. We definitely don't need or want a 4 lane road connecting to Highway 161.

The only business in Grey Cloud Island Township is Aggregate Mining Company. I noticed in this proposal that once Aggregate Mining is done, they (St. Paul Park) don't want large trucks on their roads (3rd Street, Grey Cloud Island Drive).

Preserve what Open Spaces we have left in the SWA, the Mississippi Dunes area - they are adjacent to the Grey Cloud Regional Park.

The residents of Grey Cloud Island Township, myself included, are against this. It wouldn't benefit us in any way whatsoever. We already have a road that goes to St. Paul Park & one that goes to Cottage Grove.

Your report (173 pages) refers to the cultural, historical and environmental value of this area (Mississippi Dunes, Grey Cloud Island Township (e.g. Pete Tibbitts house & barn which is across the street from the Cottage Grove (who built and ran 2 kindergartens) and was also the home of Mary O'Boyle who was →

first Postmistress in St. Paul Park. My family lived in the Creech House until I was 8 years old. Any 4 lane road would have a negative effect on the SNA, the Grey Cloud Island Township residents as well as St Paul Park.
