

COUNTY HIGHWAY 32 PEDESTRIAN AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PHASE 4 ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY - WINTER 2024

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Washington County is exploring pedestrian and safety improvements to County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 32 between I-35 and Trunk Highway 61. This study will assess intersection and traffic safety improvements, drainage improvements, and bicycle and pedestrian improvements. The fourth phase of engagement was added to the process following the third open house. As a result of the feedback gathered in Phase 3, the intersection of Forest Road and CSAH 32 was realigned and this modified design was shared with the community for feedback.
