

Open House #1 Summary

- 20 people at in-person open house – July 9
- 1,000 views of online open house
- 50 survey responses – July 9-23
- 30 mapped comments on issues maps
- 20,000 people reached on social media
- 900 project postcards mailed to area households
- 250 people reached via email

Comment summary/themes:

The following are recurring themes that have been identified through feedback gathered from the in-person and online open houses.

- **Pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure**
 - Desire for sidewalk on at least one side of the roadway
 - Desire for bikeable shoulders or dedicated bike lanes along the corridor
 - Desire for improvements regarding the ability for pedestrians to cross the roadway
 - If a sidewalk is added on only one side of the roadway, the north side was preferred
- **Traffic safety**
 - Concern about vehicle speeds/speeding
- **Property impacts**
 - Desire to reduce any necessary acquisition of private property
 - Reducing property acquisition is preferred over on-street parking
