

# County Highway 14 (47th Street) and County Highway 24 (Osgood Avenue)

April 2025 Project Update




## When is this project expected to occur?

While construction of the County Highway 14 (47th Street) and 24 (Osgood Avenue) Project in Baytown Township is substantially complete, some final work remains and will be completed this spring/summer. The remaining work includes reconstruction of the Union Pacific Railroad Crossing and the new traffic light at the intersection of Osgood Avenue and 47th Street. Roadway work is expected to begin on Monday, May 5 and will require the closure of County Highway 24 (Osgood Avenue) south of the County Highway 14/24 intersection (see map for detour route). Traffic will be maintained east and west and north of the County Highway 14 and 24 intersection. Local resident access will also be maintained.

## What hours will workers be in the area? Will they work on weekends?

Allowable working hours for this project are Monday through Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



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## Will there be dust? Noise?

Residents that live near the project should expect to see dust and hear noise from construction equipment during working hours. To help limit the amount of dust, dust control measures will be used on gravel surfaces.



## How will I get in and out of my driveway?

This project will impact the ends of all driveways along the project and will require driveways to tie into the reconstructed roadway. To tie in, the end the driveway will be removed and a new driveway surface of gravel, blacktop, or concrete will be used to match your existing driveway surface. The driveway tie-in will be completed at no cost to the property owner.

The contractor is allowed to close vehicle access to a driveway a maximum of two times for a total of 10 calendar days

to construct all items associated with the driveway, including removals. The contractor shall notify the property owner a minimum of 72 hours prior to closing vehicle access to a driveway.



## How will my trash or recycling be picked up?

The contractor will coordinate locations for trash pick-up adjacent to the active work zone and the contractor will be responsible to transport the trash receptable to and from the pick-up area on the days of scheduled pick-up.



## How will disturbed turf be re-established?

Seed will be placed for turf establishment where necessary along the project limits. This seed is placed and then left to nature to establish. We recommend property owners water these restored areas and minimize mowing until the seed has completely established.



## How will my mail be delivered?

To allow work during construction, some mailboxes will be temporarily relocated as part of the project. The contractor will identify a location for the temporary mailboxes and coordinate the location with the Postal Service. Residents will be notified once the location is known.
