### Hazardous Materials

Paints, stains, antifreeze, propane tanks, fertilizers, and household cleaners.



### Electronics

TVs, cell phones, tablets, computers, and gaming consoles.



### Batteries

Household and automotive. No electric vehicle batteries.



### Food Scraps

Fruits, vegetables, meat, bones, and dairy products.



### Recyclables

Scrap aluminum and steel, mixed recycling, and cardboard.



### Additional Items

Electrical cords, string lights, plastic bags, and plastic signs.
