What are Dislocated Worker Services?

Individualized one-on-one support from a counselor to develop a plan for employment that could include:

- Career planning & counseling
- Job search Assistance & Workshops
- Counselor-approved training
- Other support services

Who Qualifies?

Applicants must be:

- Washington County Residents
- Over 18
- Laid off within the past 12 months (due to no fault of their own)
- Eligible for unemployment insurance
- Face barriers to employment such as:
 - Lack of available jobs with earnings at a level comparable to previous position
 - Decline in the market demand for your skills
 - Need for formal training or education
